### **The Prescott and Russell Opportunities Project is seeking paid surveyors to conduct surveys**

The surveyors will collectively be responsible for interviewing more than 500 entrepreneurs through the months of April to October. Hired surveyors will be offered a compensation of \$40.00 per completed survey. The surveyors must commit to conduct at least 10 surveys each for the municipality in which they wish to get involved. Positions are available in Hawkesbury, East Hawkesbury, Champlain, Alfred and Plantagenet, Clarence-Rockland, Russell, Casselman and The Nation.
