



The Township of Champlain is a recipient of two Canadian 150 Community Infrastructure Program fund grants.

1. A grant in the amount of \$60,000 was awarded, representing 50% of the eligible costs to renovate, expand and improve the existing community centre in Vankleek Hill. Projects will include but are not be limited to the replacement of the flooring and the replacement of the roof.
2. A grant in the amount of \$22,275 representing 50% of the eligible costs was granted for the rehabilitation of the cenotaph in Vankleek. The cenotaph will be relocated to the Vankleek Hill Town Square (39 Main St.) for better accessibility.
