Precautionary Boil Water Advisory Continues in Champlain Township

VANKLEEK HILL – Due to a malfunction at the water treatment plant in Hawkesbury, the Township of Champlain and the Eastern Ontario Health Unit (EOHU) are advising people in the towns of L'Orignal and Vankleek Hill to boil their tap water before drinking it.

We are diligently working to correct the issue, however, the boil water advisory will continue as a precautionary measure, for at least 24 hours and until the water is deemed safe to consume by the Minister of Environment and Climate Change (MOECC) and the Medical Officer of Health (MOH).
